

MAST RACKS

We now have six racks, which have been set out in pairs on the lawn to the east of the clubhouse.

They have been designed and placed (29 feet apart) for use by keel-stepped and longer deck-stepped masts, and to better accommodate owners who are unable to store their masts aboard their boats. Masts with radar antennas, those which are not unrigged (such as Hunters), and those which are being worked on must remain on sawhorses.

Shorter and deck stepped masts should be stored on your boat unless there are valid reasons otherwise.

Members are welcome to use the racks, subject to the following conditions:

- Spreaders must be removed or folded.
- Large-section masts on lower crosstrees.
- Store with fore-and-aft axis vertical.
- Alleys between and on either side of the racks must be kept clear for dolly access.
