Notice of Race Fanfare Regatta 2009, Nepean Sailing Club September 12-13, 2009

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RSS).
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority for this regatta is NSC.
- 1.3. The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association (CYA) will apply.
- 1.4. The Rules and Specifications of the One design classes participating will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is only open to 505s, Albacore and fireballs.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it with the required entry fee to the NSC or your dinghy class captain by September 9th . Late entries will be accepted but are subject to a late fee of \$20 (late fee does not apply to out of town boats).

3. FEES

- 3.1. If received by June 12th , the entry fee is \$30. Cheques should be payable to: Nepean Sailing Club.
- 3.2. **Entries received after September 9th will be subject to a late fee of \$20 per boat (does not apply to out of town boats).**

4. SCHEDULE for REGATTA

Saturday September 12th 11:00 Warning Gun, 1st Race of the day

Sunday September 13^h 10:00 Warning Gun 1st race of the day

Prize giving to follow after last race .

4.2 A maximum of twelve (12) races will be sailed over the 2 days.

4.3 No warning signal will be made after 1500 on Sunday September 13.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Sailing Instructions will be posted on the west wall of Junior Sailing Clubhouse, with paper copies available for competitors at registration.

6. VENUE

6.1. Racing will take place as close to NSC as reasonable.

7. SCORING

7.1. The Low Point Scoring System will be used except as modified below.

7.2. Three races will constitute a series.

7.3. There will be one throw out when four or more races are completed. When 8 or more races are completed there will be two throw outs. There will be a maximum of 12 races.

8. PRIZES & TROPHIES

8.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 crews overall in each class with at least 9 boats registered. For fleets with fewer than 9 boats only the top crew will receive a prize

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 for the event.

11.FURTHER INFORMATION

11.1 Competitors and their immediate families are welcome to use the club facilities during the regatta.

11.2. Camping is permitted on the Club Property.
