COMMODORE'S SAIL PAST

SATURDAY JUNE 13TH, 2009

SPECIAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sail Past will commence at 14:00 hrs. Boats will be clear of the harbour by 13:00 hrs and PROCEED to the rendezvous area designated by the race committee boat flying the RC flag (likely the "Andy Haydon", White hull). This is expected to be about 1 Nm west of the NSC harbour entrance.

The Commodore will take the salute aboard 'MUIR CAILEAG' (C&C 30) anchored off Andrew Haydon Park.

The Sail Past will begin with one sound signal and a red start flag from the Race Committee boat (The "Andy Haydon") at 14:00 hrs. The lead boat with the Peter Bradley Vice Commodore on board will be a Sirius 28 called "Indecision" with white hull.

All boats shall follow in line behind the Vice Commodore, starting at the Committee Boat, GO AROUND THE DROP MARK, then cross the stern of "MUIR CAILEAG", leaving them to starboard. Salute the Commodore by luffing your jib or by dipping the Club Burgee.

Festivities will be lead by the Commodore on return to the NSC Docks.
