Notes:

- For weeknight racing, there will normally only be one race.
- If there are more than 30 finishers, you will need a second sheet. Please record at least the date and the "course", e.g. JAM or PHRF Div 3, on the second page.
- Please record names of all volunteers. This may be required for crediting volunteer RC duty credits. It would also be good to record their boat's name(s).
- Please note whether times are local (EDT) or elapsed. Either are acceptable, though local times are recommended.
- Suggest Fleets 1, 2 and 3 always be recorded in the same order, e.g. JAM A, B and C. This would be the normal start order, though in the case of a general recall, start times would be recorded as above.
Point of info:
 - BYC uses 6 minutes between starts (per OSA recommendations)
 - NSC uses 5 minutes between starts.
- Record finish times for all boats, including those that are OCS or not registered.
- Note boats that are not registered.
- Check the list of starters to make sure all sail numbers have been properly recorded, and note any boats that did not finish on the results form as DNF.

Instructions:

If using elapsed time put the time of the start (from the timer) as the start time.
 If this sheet gets messy, clean it up so the scorer can read it please.
